

Gas Emergency Stop — User Instructions

The lockable gas emergency stop button is a safety device designed to immediately shut off the gas supply to the connected system or facility in the event of an emergency. Locking functionality prevents accidental or unauthorised reactivation.

When to Use

Activate the gas emergency stop button only in the following situations:

1. You detect a gas leak (smell, sound, detection system alarm).
2. There is a fire, explosion risk, or unsafe operating condition involving gas.
3. Equipment connected to the gas supply is malfunctioning or unsafe.
4. You have been instructed to shut down the gas supply as part of an emergency response.

How to Operate

To activate (Emergency Shutdown)

Locate the button – usually red, clearly labelled "Gas Emergency Stop".

Press the button firmly until it clicks into the depressed/locked position.

The gas supply will shut off immediately.

Contact the Technical or Service Manager, and inform them why the gas emergency shut off was activated and they will arrange for any rectification works and for the gas supply to be restored.



To Reset (Authorised Personnel Only)

Ensure the area has been declared safe by a competent person (e.g., gas technician, Technical Trainer or Technical Manager).

Insert the key and unlock the emergency stop button.

Twisting the red button will release the button and will return it to the normal operating position.

Assess the gas system as required before resuming normal operation.
